We are aware of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, Section 1502, regarding reporting requirements for conflict minerals (the Act).

Conflict minerals are Columbite-tantalite (coltan), cassiterite, gold, wolframite, or their derivatives; or any other mineral or its derivatives determined by the Secretary of State to be financing conflict in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or an adjoining country. Metals derived from these minerals are tin, tantalum, tungsten, and gold.
